To be held on the beach at the conclusion of the day.

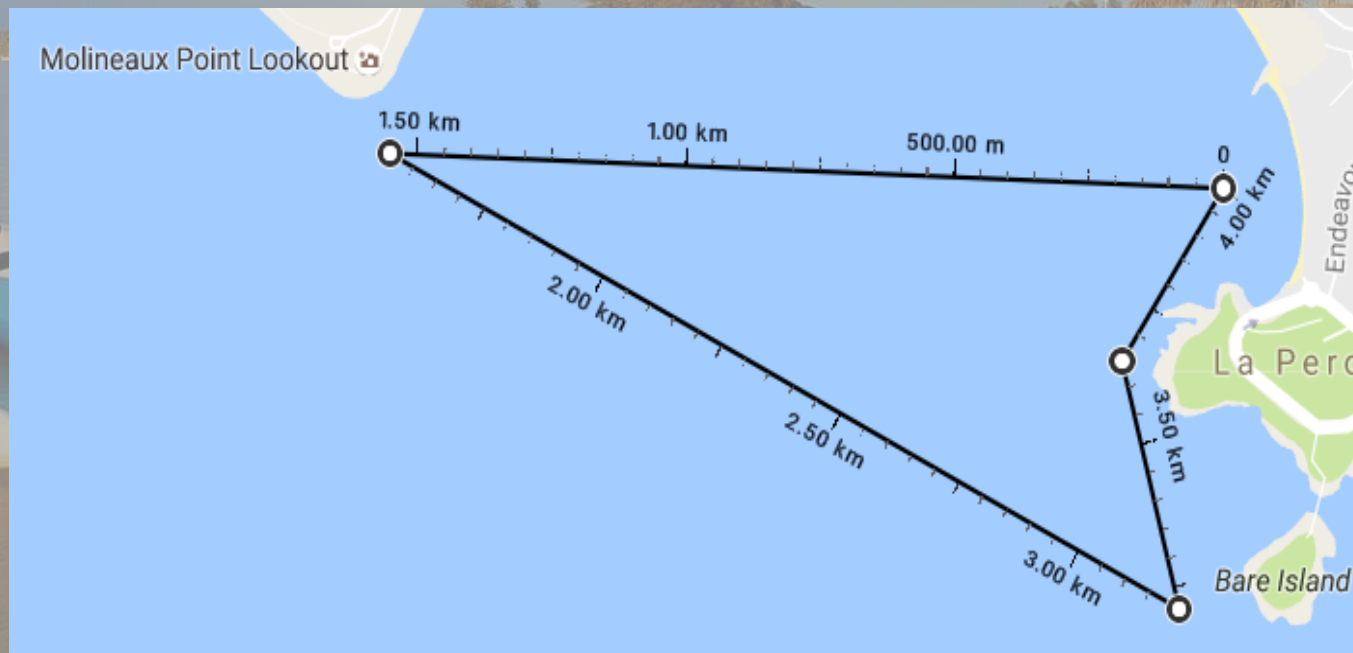
**ALL CANOES MUST HAVE STORM COVERS, 2 BAILERS, 25m TOW ROPE,

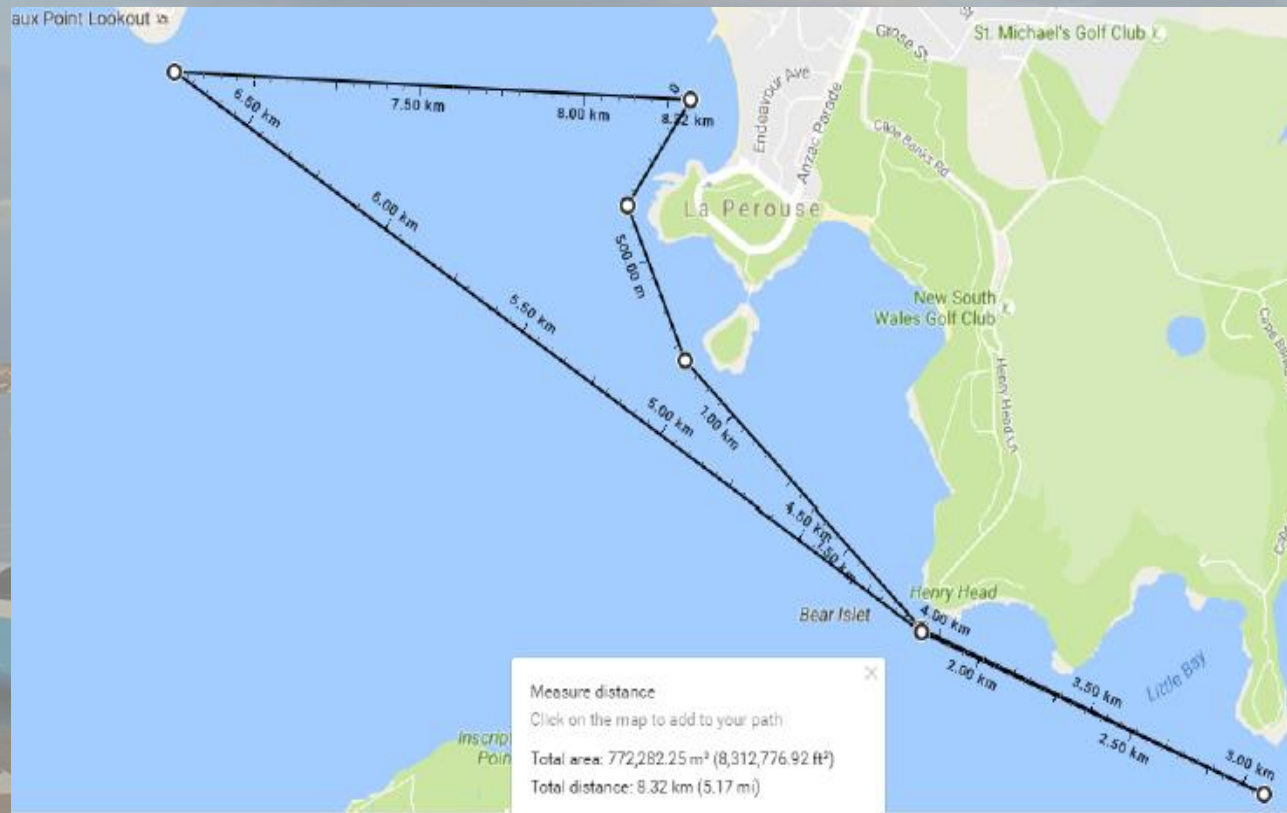
Race Information

PLEASE NOTE: Race courses subject to conditions on the day.

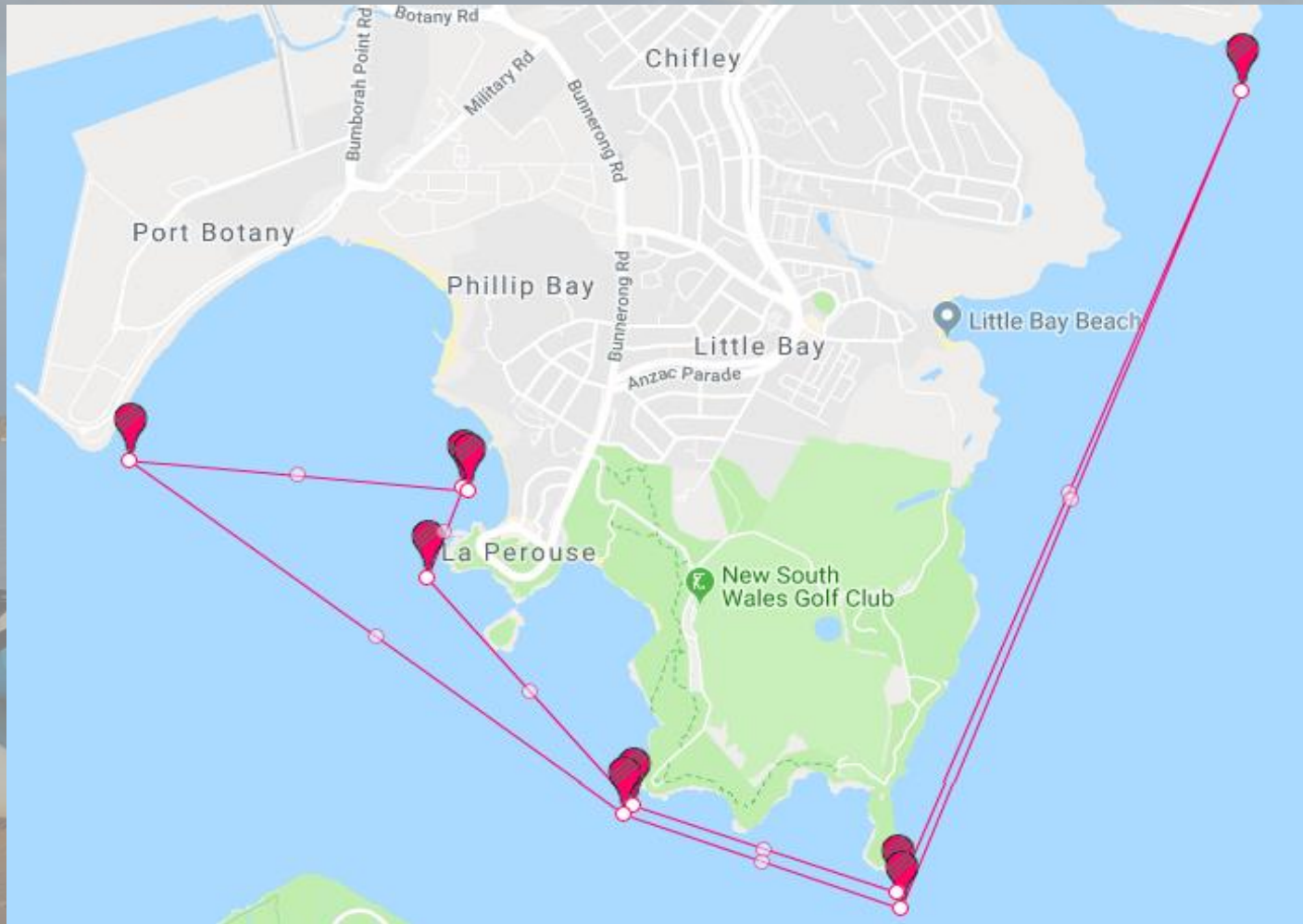
***Novelty Race 4km – Head down towards Molineaux Point ama turn then head up to Bare Island ama turn to head back home in to the beach between the starting flag and the beach.**



Short Course 8km – Head down towards Molineaux Point Lookout make an ama turn then head down towards Cape Banks, make another ama turn and head back in to the beach between the starters mark and beach.



Long Course 16km – stay clear of the headland passing Bare Island around Henry Head start heading North towards Little Bay Beach, ama turn, then come back towards Molineaux Point non ama turn and head into the beach between the start line and beach.

Race Entry Fees

Novelty Event: \$15.00 per paddler (\$90.00 per crew) *

Short Course: \$30.00 per paddler (\$180.00 per crew)

Long course: \$40.00 per paddler (\$240.00 per crew)

AGE DIVISIONS

Age Divisions for Junior Competitors Junior division competitors shall not have reached the age of 20 years during the race year of competition or be 10 years of age during the calendar year of competition.

Age Divisions for Senior Competitors.

Open – 20 yrs and above

Masters – 40 yrs and above

Senior Masters – 50 yrs and above

Golden Masters – 60 yrs and above

Platinum Masters – 70 yrs and above

Note: there must be three (3) teams to make a division

Competitor Information

Conditions of eligibility

1. Only a competitor who is a financial member of a club affiliated with AOCRA Inc. and is a current registered competitor with AOCRA Inc. is eligible to nominate and compete in any event.

2. AOCRA Inc., the Race Director, or the Race Committee reserves the right to request proof of identity or age [i.e. ID card with photograph] of a competitor at any time.

3. The Race Committee reserves the right to be the arbiter in any dispute regarding eligibility and registration of competitors. The Race Directors decision is final.

4. The REGATTA RULES [as amended] of the Australian Outrigger Canoe Racing Association Incorporated shall apply.

5. All OC6 will be required to carry 2 bailers, spare paddles, spare water, covers and 25 metre tow ropes and 6 life jackets approved by AOCRA for the events.

Safety Inspection

Members of the zone committee & host club will be performing safety inspections on all canoes. If a canoe fails to meet the required AOCRA Safety guidelines, the canoe will be ineligible to take part in the event.

Parking

There will be parking on Anzac Parade and Endeavour Avenue, with designated areas for trailers to allow easy access to the beach at the roundabout.

Amenities

There will be a BBQ, fruit, snacks and drinks available throughout the regatta. Club tents can be erected in designated areas. Male and Female toilets are provided at Frenchman's Beach Reserve and will be maintained throughout the day.

Safety

Members of the Zone Committee and host club will perform random safety inspections. Canoes not meeting AOCRA Safety Guidelines may be ineligible to race.
