2 km, 4 km & 8 km COURSE

The course will start between the Start/Finish lines being two marker buoys' located in front of the regatta site and run N/W up towards Tinaroo Park, around a marker buoy- left arm turn and head approx. 500 m towards a second buoy, where the canoes will make another left (ama) turn and head back through to the FINISH LINE IN FRONT OF TIMERS STAGE at Regatta site

4 km race is 1 x 4 km Marathon course. 8 km race is 2 x 4 km Marathon course

The 2 km course will be up to and around a buoy 1 km from the start returning to the finish line



NOTE: Course distance may be varied according to weather conditions, and start times may change, please ensure you check with race officials on the day and attend all race briefings.
