1. the canoe number

#### When Nominating for OC1/2, V1 events, individuals need to:

- 1. Confirm the division
- 2. Indicate individual/s paddling
- 3. Canoe number

#### For Club Registrars:

Each Club registrar will be asked to load their club nominations onto a pre-populated tool. The tool will be sent out to registrars about 3 weeks before the event.

Registrars will use the tool to load the nominations from their club, including the canoe number, event number and division. This will help the host club load all events into webscorer.

## SATURDAY 30th APRIL - RED CAT Adventures 'SHUTE 2 AIRLIE'



## Clubs will need to transfer their own oc6 canoes and paddlers to Shute Harbour. (Approx. 12km from Airlie Beach).

#### Where paddlers will need to offload and rig canoes for racing.

Be aware cars; buses use the roadway and boats will launch at the boat ramp.

- Outrigger Whitsunday will provide some old tyres to assist rigging on the road surface
- Once rigged and launched, paddle around to Snows beach ready for the briefing at 12.30pm
- Return the canoe trailers to VMR or Port of Airlie
- At Lagoon Beach the canoes will be stacked on the beach above the high tide mark ready for Sunday racing
- OC-2s and OC-1s will be offloaded on Sunday morning NOT Saturday

#### The Shute to Airlie race will start between two buoys off Snow's Beach at Shute Harbour.

- It will be an outgoing tide to maximise the downwind leg of the race.
- Teams will start in a southern direction towards White Rock
- There will be an Arma turn around White Rock the<mark>n head</mark> NORTH.
- Lead boat will track outside of Almora Islet (bird sh\*t rock). However, canoes can cut inside of this landmark. BEWARE OF ROCKS
- FINISH LINE will be in front of Airlie Lagoon Beach.


#### Junior – 2km course - OC6 / OC1 / OC2
