Australian Outrigger Canoe Racing Association Incorporated [Adopted 5/4/1994]

BY-LAW 4:

POWER OF AFFILIATED CLUB TO SUSPEND MEMBER:

- [1] An affiliated club shall have the power to suspend any member of its club from competing in any governed or sanctioned regatta.
- [2] A member of an affiliated club may within one month of receiving written notification thereof, lodge with the secretary of the AOCRA written notice of his or her intention to appeal to the Management Committee of the AOCRA against the suspension imposed by an affiliated club.
- [3] The Management Committee shall determine such appeal. The member and affiliated club concerned shall be given the opportunity to fully present his or her or its case. The appeal shall be determined by the vote of the members of the Management Committee present at such meeting. The Management Committee may uphold or set aside the suspension imposed by the affiliated club.
- [4] A member and affiliated club concerned shall accept and abide by the determination of the Management Committee which shall be final.
