## BY-LAW 5:

## FORMATION OF A NATIONAL JUNIOR DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE

- [1] Pursuant to the provisions of Clause 16 (1), (2) and (3) of the Rules of Incorporation of AOCRA Inc. and for the purpose of orderly management and control of junior outrigger canoe racing and development within Australia, a National Junior Development Committee shall be established.
- [2] The committee shall be known as the "Australian Outrigger Canoe Racing Association Junior Development Committee." This committee shall be a sub-committee of AOCRA Inc. and subject to the rules and policies governing subcommittees
- [3] A Management Committee shall be formed in accordance with the following guidelines:
- [4] One person from each zone will form the Junior Development Committee. If a Zone, due to the extent of area covered, requires more than one JD Officer than submissions will be considered. The JD Committee will also include 2 members of the AOCRA National committee. These 2 members may also be the zone reps.
- [5] Zones will submit their nominations to the Junior Development committee at the AOCRA AGM for approval and ratification by the elected AOCRA committee.
- [6] The Chairperson shall be appointed by AOCRA Inc. and will be responsible to AOCRA Inc. for the upholding of AOCRA Inc, Rules and policies.
- 7] The Rules of Incorporation of AOCRA Inc., shall apply as far as relevant to the Sub-Committee.
- [8] A decision, rule, motion or resolution of the Junior Development sub-committee, contrary to any decision,

rule, motion or resolution of the Management Committee of AOCRA Inc. shall be of no effect. However the Management Committee of AOCRA Inc will not over rule the JD Sub-committee without appropriate discussion and mutual agreement.

- [9] The Chairperson or his/her elect will present a report at all AOCRA meetings for discussion and ratification.
- [10] A Junior development account has been established. All expenditure recommended by the JD committee must be ratified / approved by the AOCRA committee.
