

## SAFETY BRIEFING & BLESSING OF THE FLEET

9:00am

Blessing will take place directly after briefing and immediately prior to race start.

#### **RACE START**

All divisions 9.30am

Craft to assemble between the two buoys adjacent to beach.

Flags will be signalled from the start boat.

Paddlers take best line NNW to Haycock Island (Scout's Hat). Smile for the cameras on way past Double Island, then run home to Port.

#### **RACE FINISH**

Cross the finish line between two large orange buoys, directly adjacent to Four Mile Beach Port Douglas Surf Lifesaving Club flags.

Paddlers should anticipate and prepare for being on the water for 3 ½ to 5 hours.

Cut Off 5 1/2 hours.

Note: if you have passed the prominent headland (known locally as Moby's Dick), you've gone too far!

Allow about 1 hour to return by car to Yorkeys Knob.

Talk to organisers about shuttle bus or share ride options.





## LOCAL INFORMATION

#### **BE CROC WISE & SUN SMART**



Cairns is in croc territory. Local paddlers are aware of this but most have never seen or encountered a croc while paddling. We avoid paddling in rivers and estuaries, particularly at dusk. Your marine encounters are more likely to be with a turtle or dolphin. Box jellyfish are not present in our waters between May and November. You may still consider wearing long sleeves and leggings for sun protection.

### **KEEP HYDRATED**



Even in winter, it's warmer than you expect and conditions are likely to be different to what you're been training in. It's imperative paddlers keep well hydrated during and in the days leading up to races. Carry enough water and food with you to stay energised, particularly during GBROC, when you can be on the water for up to four hours or more.

#### **CANCELLATION & REFUND POLICY**

#### **EFFECTIVE 30 NOVEMBER 2021**

- The Host, Zone or AOCRA may cancel an event inline with the AOCRA Rules.
- Cancellation more than 30 days before the event is at minimum a 80% refund of the Host, Zone and AOCRA portion of the nomination fee.
- Cancellation more than 7 days before the event is at minimum an 70% refund of the Host, Zone and AOCRA portion of the nomination fee.
- Cancellation more than 1 day before the event is at minimum a 60% refund of the Host, Zone and AOCRA portion of the nomination fee.
- Cancellation on the day of the event is at minimum a 40% refund of the Host, Zone and AOCRA portion of the nomination fee.
- The Host, Zone and / or AOCRA reserve the right to refund at a greater value of their po rtion of the nomination fee only than the stated cancellation terms above.
- Refunds will be processed within 30 days of cancellation via the same method used for payment

#### **Postponement**

- Should the Host, Zone or AOCRA postpone an event, they are required to give notice at any time prior to the scheduled start time of an event.
- A date for the rescheduled event must be announced within 7 days of the original event date in writing by: email, sms alert notification or text message to your mobile device, Host Facebook page, written announcement on the AOCRA website. The Host reserves the right to postpone the event (where no refund will be issued).
- The rescheduled event program content / format may change including scheduled times which is at the discretion of the Host and they reserve the right to do without notice.
- The Host, Zone or AOCRA may continue to postpone an event following the same process as above

#### **Nominee cancellation**

- Once the nomination fee is paid there is no refund for change of mind.
- If you have paid the nomination fee and are unable to attend the event due to extenuating circumstances outside of your control, you may apply in writing using the AOCRA Request for Refund Form on the AOCRA website and email to support@aocra.com.au giving details of the reason for requesting a refund.
- The Host, Zone and AOCRA are not obligated to refund their respective portions of the nomination fee, and if a refund is approved it will be processed in full less an administration fee of up to \$10 for processing the refund.
- AOCRA determines the administration fee at the time of processing a refund and retains the administration fee to cover their processing costs.
- The nominee cannot request a refund on the day of the event or after the start date of the event.
