The Wavemasters Classic is back for 2025.

After a successful event last year featuring new start, finish and accommodation location at Camp Grace, and a reduced entry price as lunch is now self-catered, and an official after party we are gearing up to do it all again.

The Wavemasters Classic is a shallow water/beach change relay, consisting of a variety of paddling conditions to suit all members of our Zone. There will be 2 re-grouping points during the race, the end of leg 2 and 4. The race clock will stop at the re-grouping points. The times for the day will be added together with the fastest overall winning The Wavies Classic Tiki Trophy.

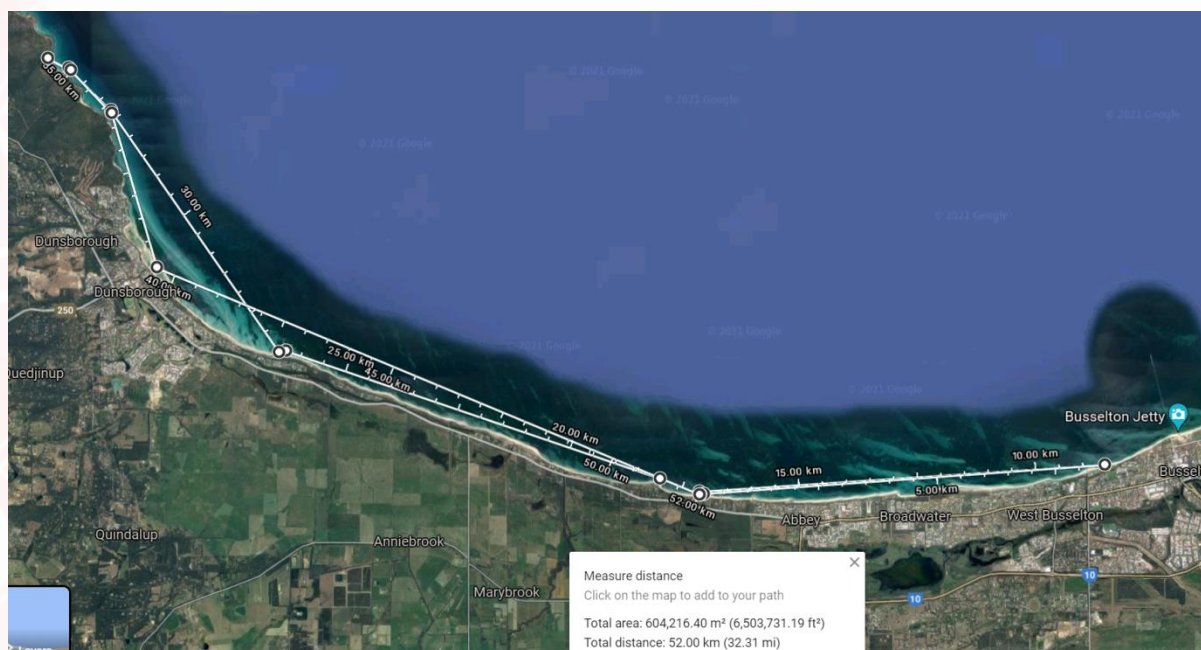

- Mixed Category = no more than 3 men in the canoe at any one time
- Teams are to have minimum 6 paddlers, maximum of 16 paddlers.
- Junior's U14 years can do any leg 1 to 4 (with parental and coach permission slip signed, see last page)
- Junior's U16+ can race in any leg.

Leg 1	Camp Grace to Geographe Bay Yacht Club	(8.5km)
Leg 2	Geographe Bay Yacht Club to Camp Grace	(8.5km)
Leg 3	Camp Grace to Dunsborough Bay Yacht Club	(9km)
Leg 4	Dunsborough Bay Yacht Club to Meelup Beach	(8km)
Leg 5	Meelup Beach to Camp Grace (via Dunsborough Beach)	(18km)



NOTE: Course distance may be varied according to weather conditions, and start times may change, please ensure you check with race officials on the day and attend the race briefing. Alternate racecourse is to run the legs in the reverse direction.

If you have a paddler doing leg 1, 2 and 3, they enter 1 x OC1.
