The organisers will acknowledge age categories (Open, Master, Senior Master, Golden Master, Platinum Master) within the Men's and women categories; however, there must be a minimum of 3 paddlers in a specific category for it to be acknowledged.

- The Major prize of an economy return plane ticket to the 2014 Te Aito (18 & 19th July in Tahiti) will be awarded to the first paddler across the line in the following categories: 19U Boys, 19U Girls

Race Courses

All races will be held in open water from Mooloolaba Beach (near the rock wall at the Spit). If conditions do not allow for open water paddling, all races will be held in the Mooloolah River, north of the Coast Guard station on Parkyn Parade.

Va'a/Waka

- No Va'a/Waka shall be permitted to have a rudder
- Va'a/Waka will not be weighed
