CLUB NOMINATIONS

All clubs must lodge a CLUB NOMINATION with payment, performed online, V3 nominations must nominate 3 times per canoe.

Individuals wishing to compete in an OC1/2 event can lodge a "CLUB NOMINATION" with payment by credit card, at www.aocra.com.au

All nominations close at 5pm Saturday two weeks prior to your regatta, 19th May 2018

Late nominations will be accepted with additional late fee of

\$10 per senior paddler for OC1/OC2 events and \$10 per senior paddler for OC6 events

TEAM and INDIVIDUAL NOMINATIONS

(ie the name of individuals eligible to paddle in each race in each division) must be lodged online at www.aocra.com.au no later than

5pm Friday one week prior to your regatta, 24th May 2018

If nominations are not received for certain divisions, the host club will organize to delete these from the schedule of events. Age divisions may be merged up (Excluding Open division) if insufficient nominations are received to race the division itself.

When **Signing In** for *OC6* events clubs need to indicate:

- 1. which individuals are in each crew for the upcoming race
- 2. the <u>canoe number</u> (<u>and any identifying feature</u> e.g. sponsor name)
- 3. crew name (if applicable)

When **Signing In** for *OC1/2 events* individuals need to:

- 1. Confirm the division
- 2. Indicate individual/s paddling
- 3. Canoe number (and any identifying feature eg colour of ama)

It would be appreciated if paddlers do not approach the Sign In desk until they have all of the above details.

Junior OC6

All junior divisions will complete a 500m Course

Junior OC1 & OC2

12U & 14U will complete a 250m Course 16U & 19U will complete a 500m Course

In accordance with Matters for attention March 2018 Junior 14U OC6 crews may be directed to race with an adult steerer/paddler if conditions deem it necessary

- 1. The starting line is between the buoys on the Eastern end of the 250m and 500m short courses
- 2. Proceed West very quickly for 250 m (12U & 14U) or 500m (all other divisions) to the finish line.

NOTE: Course direction may be varied according to weather conditions and tides. Start times may change, please ensure you check with race officials on the day and attend all race briefings.


