The Race Program will run on time, or at the discretion of the Race Director. Clubs must provide adequate canoes for competitors in each division. Please be ready for your event. The Race Director will not wait for crews to get to the START LINE.

Please note that races may be brought forward on the day so please notify all competitors that it is important to listen for changes over the PA system.

All canoes are required to carry one PFD per paddler, and must be easily accessible.

- 3. crew name (if applicable)

When **<u>Signing In</u>** for OC1/2 events individuals need to:

- 1. Confirm the division
- 2. Indicate individual/s paddling
- 3. Canoe number (and any identifying feature eg colour of ama)

It would be appreciated if paddlers do not approach the Sign In desk until they have all of the above details.



OC2&6 2km

Beach to buoy 3 ama turn and back to finish.

OC2&6 4km

Beach to buoy 4 ama turn and back to finish.

OC6 12km

Beach two laps of whole triangle through finish.

OC6 1km Minnow & 12

From minnow start 1km straight to finish to finish. The course is within 200m of shore.

OC1 2km Relay (junior) 500m lap

Beach to buoy 1 ama turn and back to beach change paddler repeat 4 times finish.

OC6 500m Straight Sprint

Buoy 2 to finish.

OC1 4km Relay (senior) 1km lap

Beach to buoy 2 ama turn and back to beach change paddler repeat 4 times finish.

STARTS

All starts must have one crew member standing beside the canoe.

Until the green start flag goes up. (Should there be a northerly a start line will be set off shore)

FINISH

SENIOR between finish boat and inflatable buoy approximately 50m off beach. JUNIOR between finish boat and yellow special mark at end of rock wall.

NOTE: Course distance may be varied according to weather conditions, and start times may change, please ensure you check with race officials on the day and attend all race briefings.
