Rules/Safety

All AOCRA rules and regulations will be enforced, as per the AOCRA Regatta Rules available under the Administration tab on the AOCRA website – www.aocra.com.au

IMPORTANT NOTE: Junior Ruling

OC6 Crews must consist of a maximum of 3 males, as per AOCRA rule change 1st July 2016. Minnows: no gender requirements. All Junior events are Mixed only.

OC1/ OC2: PFDs and leg ropes are required. V1: PFD, leg rope and bailer are required.

Please note if you are borrowing an AOCRA canoe you will need to supply your own bailers, PFDs and leg ropes.

OC6: Spare Blade & bailers, 6 Life jackets.

Nomination information

All competitors must register online at www.aocra.com.au before race day.

Nominations close midnight Wednesday 18th September 2019 Team nominations close 22nd September 2019. It is not possible to register on the day.

A fee of \$20 per paddler for late nominations will apply. The RACE DIRECTOR will have the discretion to not allow late registrations to paddle if he or she has concerns about the paddler/support boat ratio.

Canoe Borrowing

AOCRA V1s and OC1s will be available to loan for \$20 (GST inc) per race. This will be done via the website nomination process – There are a limited amount of canoes. Please select in 'club extras' and also put in notes. Note: OC2s are no longer available to loan.

Please email <u>steff.cullen1@gmail.com</u> with your requirement and we will endeavour to assist you. Paddlers from outside of SQ Zone will get priority.

Please note you will need to bring your own OC6 canoe or make your own arrangements.

Registration / Wrist Bands

As this is a national titles wrist bands must be worn for the duration of the event. Have student ID or be accompanied by parent or guardian. Registration for all V1/OC1/OC2s and OC6 will be at the registration tent at the regatta site.

All paddlers must sign-in at the registration and confirm canoe/ craft number for each race.

Race Courses

Conditions will determine the best possible option on the day. The Race Director reserves the right to change schedule and distances raced. <u>Please attend all briefings</u> for confirmation of the final race courses.

AOCRA 2019 NATIONAL OC1 / OC2 / V1 JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS

2nd/3rd October Lake Kawana, Sunshine Coast.

PADDLER INFORMATION

- 1. <u>TRAVEL ASSISTANCE</u> is available to all AOCRA financial members travelling from a location that is greater than 1000km from the event. Forms are due NO LATER than 2 weeks after the event. There is a pool of AOCRA funds that will be made available for this, the number of paddlers that apply for this allowance will determine the amount paid. Payments are capped at a maximum of \$120 per paddler.
 Forms and instructions have been updated and simplified and can be found on the AOCRA website [Off the Water / Administration / Travel / Assistance Rules & Request for Travel Assistance Form].
- 2. TOWING ASSISTANCE is available for trailers carrying a minimum of 6 OC1/OC2/V1 craft to the event travelling from a location that is greater than 1000km from the event. Forms are due NO LATER than 2 weeks after the event. Payments will be capped at a maximum of \$500 per trailer. Form can be found on the AOCRA website [Off the Water / Administration / Travel / Request for Towing Assistance].
- CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP TROPHY To be awarded to the club with the highest points based on the National OC1/OC2/V1 Title events and National OC6 – points are allocated to each paddler based on their AOCRA registered club.
- 4. PRIZE UP TO 6 RETURN FLIGHTS TO NEW ZEALAND (Capped at \$450 each) TO COMPETE AT THE 2020 AOTEAROA AITO (V1)
 The first Australian V1 Paddler to cross the finish line in the V1 National Title event for U16 Boys, U16 Girls, U19 Boys, U19 Girls will win \$450 towards return flights to compete at the above event. (to be eligible must be financial AOCRA members and eligible to compete in the same age division in 2020 One prize per paddler)

Rules:

- a) AOCRA will reimburse the cost of return flights to NZ to the winners (up to a maximum of \$450 each) This can be done by completing a 'request for reimbursement form' found on the AOCRA website [Off the Water/Administration/Forms].
- b) Flights are to attend the 2020 Aotearoa Aito, Kohimarama Beach, Auckland, NZ on 9th March 2020, not transferable for use at other events/locations.
- c) Prize is only valid to the winners, not transferable to any other party.
- d) Winners are responsible for organising entries/canoe hire/accommodation & chaperones.
- e) Eligibility to win Prize
 - U16 Boys/Girls must be eligible to complete in U16 in 2020 to win the prize. If the winner moves into U19 in 2020 then prize is awarded to the next eligible placing.
 - U19 Boys/Girls Must be eligible to complete in U19 in 2020 to win the prize. If the winner moves into U21/Open in 2020 then prize is awarded to the next eligible placing.
 - Wild Card Prize if an U16 2nd year is the first V1 across the line but becomes ineligible to win the prize due to the above age rule then the AOCRA JD can award a wild card prize. This will entitle them to flight reimbursement to complete in U19 age division in New Zealand.
 - No Wild Card Prize is available for U19 division.
- AOCRA CRAFT AOCRA will supply a limited number of V1, OC1, for use at the event. Priority will be given to competitors traveling the longest distances. Craft must be pre-booked by contacting steff.cullen1@gmail.com by 24th September 2019.
