





Race Rules/ Safety

All AOCRA rules and regulations will be enforced, as per the AOCRA Regatta Rules available under the Administration tab on the AOCRA website. However, please note:

- Women racing in Men's crews <u>must</u> ask for permission before nominating.
- ❖ <u>ALL AUSTRALIAN</u> outrigger paddlers must be current AOCRA members AND members of an affiliated Club.
- ❖ <u>INTERNATIONAL PADDLERS</u> must sign a waiver form and have proof of their travel insurance to cover overseas competition. Must also be able to demonstrate membership of an IVF affiliated club.
- ALL Steerers <u>must</u> attend all briefings as per race program - 6.30am race days
- ❖ Race Registrations: Steerers must sign in their crew before each race. All paddlers will be checked against the nominated team list.
- ❖ Steerers from each crew will be asked to provide a mobile phone number (local accommodation mobile where possible) to an Event Coordinator at the Opening/Welcome who will be sending out any updates via SMS to the nominated crew contact.
