The 2025 SQ Zone Championships event is being hosted by South Queensland Zone with the support of Mooloolaba Outrigging Canoe Club. This event encourages and promotes outrigger paddling while sharing the uniqueness of Mooloolaba Spit.

The SQ Zone welcome teams outside of the Zone to enter. However, results from their races will not be entitled to 2024 Championship medals or the results tally for SQ Zone Clubs.

Race Rules/Safety

All AOCRA rules and regulations will be enforced, as per the AOCRA Regatta Rules available under the Administration tab on the AOCRA website.

All Paddlers must wear club uniforms

Mandatory safety regulation will apply

- PFD's (one per paddler) in all crafts NOTE: Recent updates to Aocra rules - PFD's not to be inflatable type.
- At least 1 Spare blade per craft (all crafts)

Small Crafts:

- Oc1 / Oc2 must have attached leg leash
- V1must have bailer and covers (if provided)
- V3 / Oc3 must have bailers & Covers (if provided) and toe rope attached
- Long course Mobile phones in waterproof case with webscorer app activated

OC6 crafts:

- All Covers, at least 2 bailers and Tow ropes in all crafts
- Long course Mobile phones in waterproof case with webscorer app activated
- Minnows, non-inflatable PFD's to be worn

All OC6 canoes shall be a minimum weight of 130 kgs unless in the unlimited class. Unlimited Class OC6 canoes weighing less than 130 kgs may race in the short and long courses in the "Unlimited division only" for Women, Men and Mixed. ie 1 division for all ages in this class.

OC6 - Aggregate Age will be offered for clubs with 49 members or less only.

Scrutineering -All canoes will be scrutineered at the rigging and trailer parking area. NOT ON THE BEACH. All canoes are to have correct items in the canoes - bailers, spare paddle, ropes, PFDs. Mooloolaba and Panamuna please bring your canoes into the rigging area for scrutineering

Nominations close midnight Sunday 6th April 2025

Registrations after midnight (AEST Qld) of the advertised cut off will incur a late fee (Seniors \$100/ Juniors \$50). Club Registrars are requested to include Canoe Number on team sheets by cut off.

<u>On the day</u>: all team captains must sign-in at the registration tent prior to the event and confirm their team members as recorded on team sheet. All paddlers are to attend briefings prior to race start.

Composite crews = Entries from various AOCRA Clubs for team entries for Juniors, Golden Masters and Platinum Masters (competing in the same division ie. Junior, Golden and Platinum Masters) are allowed

Due to new QLD Maritime Legislation – approved lifejackets must be WORN crossing the Mooloolah River Bar – Estuary to Beach and return.

TEAM / INDIVIDUAL RACE REGISTRATION

All steerers/captains (OC6) must sign in their crew before each race and confirm canoe number and show that Webscorer App is loaded and active on mobile device. Registration for GPS Tracking must be completed before briefing.

All individual competitors (OC1/OC2/V1/V3/OC3) must sign in and confirm canoe number and show that Webscorer App is loaded and active on mobile device. Includes short and long course. Registration and sign in must be completed before briefing.










Race Courses Friday 11th April 2025 – Small Craft Championships












Saturday 12th April 2025 – OC6 Championships

Start and Finish Lines

Start line between the orange buoys offshore, from Mooloolaba Spit.

Finish line is inside of the marker closest to the rock wall.











The Beach Relay will be five laps of a 2-kilometre circuit: around marker one then two. Changes happen at the beach. Start and finish lines are consistent with day one and two of competition




Alternative Course (due to adverse weather AOCRA rule 8.2

The alternative course for the Beach Relays will be a reverse direction of the 2-kilometre course to minimise waves under the ama and reduce the capsizing risk.

Right of Way Rules


Figure 1 Diagram depicting examples of "right of way" rules with the circle depicting two canoe lengths.

(please note in the second example canoe c does not get right of way until they are within 2 canoe lengths of the turn).

Facilities on the Day

Food stalls and coffee vans will operate throughout the event. There are also retail outlets within the cul-de-sac area. Paddling merchandise tents will be trading on the day.

First Aid will be on site throughout the event.









AOCRA Refund Policy in the event of Postponement and or Cancellation

Refund policy may vary depending on the type of event and the Host or Organiser. The Host of each event must include a Refund Policy in the approved Regatta / Event Program outlining the terms for eligibility to request a refund. The Refund Policy must be the same wording as outlined in the AOCRA Rules, otherwise, the Host must seek approval from AOCRA Events for any changes prior to publishing a Refund Policy in the approved Regatta / Event program. The Refund Policy applies to nomination fees paid to enter a sanctioned AOCRA event only.

Nominee Cancellation Prior to the Event Date

Change of Mind or Unable to Attend

Once the nomination fee is paid there is no refund for change of mind. If you have paid the nomination fee and are unable to attend the event due to extenuating circumstances outside of your control, you may apply in writing using the AOCRA Request for Refund Form on the AOCRA website and email to support@aocra.com.au giving details of the reason for requesting a refund. The Host, Zone and AOCRA are not obligated to refund their respective portions of the nomination fee, and if a refund is approved it will be processed in full less an administration fee of up to \$10 for processing the refund. AOCRA determines the administration fee at the time of processing a refund and retains the administration fee to cover their processing costs. The nominee cannot request a refund on the day of the event or after the start date of the event.

Host Postpones or Cancels the Event

Host Giving Notice of Postponement or Cancellation

The Host must follow the AOCRA Rules to postpone or cancel an event and give notice in writing by: email, sms alert notification or text message to your mobile device, Host Facebook post, written announcement on the AOCRA website. The effective date is the date of dispatch.

Event Postponed

Should the Host, Zone or AOCRA postpone an event, they are required to give notice at any time prior to the scheduled start time of an event. A date for the rescheduled event must be announced within 7 days of the original event date in writing by: email, sms alert notification or text message to your mobile device, host or SQ ZONE Facebook page, written announcement on the AOCRA website. The Host reserves the right to postpone the event (where no refund will be issued). The rescheduled event program content / format may change including scheduled times which is at the discretion of the Host, and they reserve the right to do without notice. The Host, Zone or AOCRA may continue to postpone an event following the same process as above.

Event Cancelled

• The Host, Zone or AOCRA may cancel an event in line with the AOCRA Rules.

• Cancellation more than 30 days before the event is at minimum a 80% refund of the Host, Zone and AOCRA portion of the nomination fee.

- Cancellation more than 7 days before the event is at minimum an 70% refund of the Host, Zone and AOCRA portion of the nomination fee
- Cancellation more than 1 day before the event is at minimum a 60% refund of the Host, Zone and AOCRA portion of the nomination fee.

• Cancellation on the day of the event is at minimum a 40% refund of the Host, Zone and AOCRA portion of the nomination fee.

• The Host reserves the right to refund at a greater value of their portion of the nomination fee only, than the stated cancellation terms above.

• AOCRA reserves the right to refund at a greater value of their portion of the nomination fee only, than the stated cancellation terms above.

Refund Payment

Refunds will be processed within 30 days of cancellation via the same method used for payment.
