Summary of our proposal

The total amount we request is \$2,885 for all 3 items. It will pay for:

• a portion of the works required to refurbish three canoes (incl. labour and materials) = \$750

(the total cost is \$3,800. We have Moreton Bay Regional Council funding and Stronger Communities Federal funding to cover the remaining amount)

- canoe signage promoting Bribie Island Busy Fingers per sqm (signage both sides of canoe)
 \$1500
- Uniform signage and logos promoting Bribie Island Busy Fingers (12 uniforms plus artwork, 12 uniforms = 2 canoe crews)
 = \$ 635

You may wish understandably on this first occasion to consider 1 or 2 of the above items rather than all 3

Communications

- Between the 'Bribie Islander', '102.5FM', and the 'Bribie Weekly', BIMOCC has featured in 25 local and regional articles and has been invited to speak by VMR, the Pumicestone Probus Club, and the Bribie Island Lions Club and has done radio interviews since its establishment 7 February 2017. The club will always acknowledge its current sponsors when being interviewed.
- Sponsor Logo in all media distribution e.g. in our weekly internal newsletter 'Paddlers Post'
 in our correspondence with other clubs, in our social media local community pages.

- uniforms with **Bribie Island's Busy Fingers** logo and signage will be worn at all official club events both on Bribie Island and at Zone and National Outrigger Canoeing Events.
- an invitation to people in independent living units at Foley Street to try out outrigger canoeing under the guidance of our experienced paddlers.

Promotion

 BIMOCC 'Busy Fingers' branded canoe and uniform signage will gain local exposure during training and social paddles in Pumicestone and surrounding waterways. We are on the water morning and afternoons most days of the week as well as on Sunday Club Days.

- BIMOCC has a close relationship with 1) Volunteer Marine Rescue 2) Bribie Island Sailing
 Club; and 3) Bribie Island Boating Club. Indirect exposure will occur through club interaction
 with its neighbours, fellow affiliate canoe outrigger clubs x 25, racing across locations as far
 up as Tannum Sands, out to Norfolk Island, and down to Northern Rivers NSW, and Coffs
 Harbour, NSW.
- BIMOCC has a trained adaptive coach. For 2019, it allows the club to deliver specialised training to persons with impairment / disabilities. This stretches exposure further than BIMOCC's current networks and areas of operation.
- In 2019, BIMOCC is pilot to a state / zone led project when it comes to resourcing clubs more and using smarter strategies to do so. Sponsor exposure will reach further across QLD via the Zones Facebook page and VLOGS.
- All BIMOCC canoes are racing vessels. Exposure will occur at racing events where there is TV
 and radio coverage e.g. Paddle Life TV, Creek to Coast, and Channel 10 regional news.
 BIMOCC is currently the youngest club in its paddling community, and is considered,
 'newsworthy'.
