Summary of your proposal

The total amount we request is \$2,310. It will pay for:

- a portion of the works required to refurbish three canoes (incl. labour and materials) = \$750 (the total cost is \$3,400. We have Moreton Bay Regional Council funding to cover the remaining amount)
- canoe signage promoting Bribie Island RSL per sqm = \$1500
- 6 x 'Fair Play' bi-monthly awards to recognise BIMOCC members who exude the club's values and culture such as team spirit, volunteering, paddling achievements, charitable deeds etc. = \$60

- BIMOCC has a trained adaptive coach. For 2019, it allows the club to deliver specialised training to persons
 with impairment / disabilities. This stretches exposure further than BIMOCC's current networks and areas of
 operation.
- In 2019, BIMOCC is pilot to a state / zone led project when it comes to resourcing clubs more and using smarter strategies to do so. Sponsor exposure will reach further across QLD via the Zones Facebook page and VLOGS.
- All BIMOCC canoes are racing vessels. Exposure will occur at racing events where there is TV and radio coverage eg. Paddle Life TV, Creek to Coast, and Channel 10 regional news. BIMOCC is currently the youngest club in its paddling community, and is considered, 'newsworthy'.
