2. MEETINGS:

a. **DAY 1**

There will a meeting at the completion of the OC6 final race of the qualifying teams for Master 50 (Senior Masters) Master 60 (Golden Masters) Master 70 (Platinum Masters) Team captains/ coach and managers are expected to attend. We will give information regarding the next steps in the process for registering team with IVF, timelines and expectations.

b. DAY 2

There will a meeting at the completion of the OC1 final race for the qualifying teams /individuals for the Under 19 / Open and Master Elite Squads. All persons who qualify either through OC6 or OC1 are



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expected to attend along with coaches. We will give information regarding the next steps in the process for final selection.

3. SELECTION CAMP:

The initial Selection Camp will be held at Cronulla OCC Gunnamatta Park NSW on the 6th and 7th April. Details regarding this camp will be given at the meeting of those who qualify. The teams will be selected within a week of this selection camp. The location of future training camps will be dependent on where the squad members are based. We would anticipate a final training camp with the complete squad before the Championships. We will be implementing **FAIR POOLING** for this camp and future camps. This means all participants will pay a cost to help offset the travel cost of participants travelling from more than 350ks away. This figure will be determined after we see who has qualified to attend the selection camp. More information will be forthcoming at the meeting on Day 2.

4. COMPETITOR ELIGIBILITY:

To be eligible to compete at this event you must be:

- A) An AOCRA member and
- B) An Australian Citizen or have been a resident of Australia for at least 6 months prior to this event.
- C) Provide photo ID at registration. All competitors will be issued with a wrist band. These will also be used as lunch vouchers.
